Tour Teller App. The mapping application will come back online. The cost to update the app is \$1400, this will be an upcoming project. **Update: The mapping function is not currently working on the app.**

Midland Days at Divide (MDAD). The symposium is scheduled for Saturday, September 9th at the John Wesley Ranch. Presenters will include Ken Valles, Mel McFarland, Dwight Haverkorn, Art Crawford and Dave Martinek. **Update: the symposium was held with 40 in attendance**. A check for the "partners share" of the entry fees from Midland Days will be deposited soon.

Dinner will be catered by McGinty's and will be pulled pork, rolls and butter, baked beans, cole slaw and salad. The Creek will supply pies for dessert. The theme will be "Thankful for our Past."
